#### **Community Philanthropy Program**

Since 2020, Amigos de San Cristóbal A.C. (ASC) has been implementing its Community Philanthropy Program, whose objective is to promote community philanthropy as a tool to build awareness and agents of change to positively impact in the lives of children and families who are affected by social injustice in the Chiapas Highlands, both in rural and urban spaces.

To achieve this objective, we're advancing different strategies over the program's

three years. One such strategy is the creation of six Giving Circles, which unite forces among people to work against inequalities and injustices here in the Chiapas Highlands, and to actively change the systems that produce and maintain these issues.




#### Amigos de San Cristóbal A.C.'s Giving Circles

A Giving Circle (GC) is a group of people who are motivated by their shared values to come together and build a network that pools time, talent, treasure, and testimony. Among them, they multiply these resources and their impact by giving them to Amigos de San Cristóbal A.C. As a community foundation, ASC strategically invests these resources in the Chiapas Highlands community through its local grantees.

We're working to build six Giving Circles. Four are here in the Chiapas Highlands: one is made up of people from around the world who live in San Cristóbal de Las Casas (Neighbors for Integral Change), one is with Tseltal people (Sekj'ubal Kuxlejal), one is made up of Tsotsil people, and one is with local people from the San Cristóbal area. The fifth GC is at the national level made up of people from states all around Mexico (Compas de la Montaña), and the last one is

at the international level, with people who live in different parts of the world with strong connections to the Chiapas Highlands (Roots for Change).



**Active Communities Fund** 



The Alliance of Community Foundations (Comunalia), to which Amigos de San Cristóbal A.C belongs, developed a fund to improve the capacity of community foundations to support grassroots initiatives in response to the COVID-19 pandemic, emphasizing the community

development component and the role of the community in decision making project execution.

In order to achieve this fund, Amigos de San Cristóbal joins in efforts with allies such as The Alliance of Community Foundations (Comunalia), Inter American Foundation (IAF), and the Charles Stewart Mott Foundation.

On Friday June 18th, 2021, we signed the Active Communities Fund's collaboration agreement with the organizations we will be working with in this second phase. For being a part of this project, we would like to congratulate:
