COMMUNITY PHILANTHROPY WORKSHOP

On April 8, we participated, along with partner organizations and members of giving circles, in a workshop on community philanthropy. The session was facilitated by Dr. Sergio Cruz Hernández, a professor at the Universidad Autónoma de Baja California in Ensenada, and collaborates with Fondo Acción Solidaria, A. C. (FASOL).

The purpose of the workshop was the exchange of knowledge and experiences around philanthropic practices, mainly around the processes of recovery of memory in the communities, to recognize the contributions in time of women and men, to make visible the symbolic valuation of the territory; as well as to see the tangible and intangible resources contributed by all those involved in the project (not only the donors), based

on the main findings obtained in the study "Mobilization of resources among grassroots groups in Mexico" (2021) and the results of the project "Strengthening community philanthropy in Mexico" (2023).



INTERACTIVE EDUCATIONAL MATERIAL

In early June we launched our "Interactive Educational Material", a booklet translated into Tsotsil, Tzeltal and English, which contains information and exercises for giving circles to reflect on community philanthropy issues in a fun and educational way.

The printed version will also include two dynamics for board games, one of cards with questions about the environment and the other with questions about philanthropy.



We had the opportunity to introduce them to the philanthropic work being carried out at Amigos de San Cristobal and the projects we support. The young people, most of whom

are studying International Relations, learned about the current context of Chiapas and the work of civil associations.

We also visited with them the Hogar Comunitario Yach'il Antzetic, where their collaborators talked to them about the work they do with women.

On April 16, 17 and 18, the IBERO-AMERICAN ENCOUNTER OF CIVIL SOCIETY (Collaboration with Impact), organized by the Mexican Center for Philanthropy, CEMEFI, was held at the Universidad Centro in Mexico City.

The main theme of the event was "The power of collaboration to achieve just social change" and the objective was: "To promote the building of bridges of co-responsibility to address interconnected regional problems that require coordinated".




EQUITACH EVENT (THERAPEUTIC RIDING OF LOS ALTOS DE CHIAPAS)

Congratulations to the different delegations of athletes, coaches and family members; thank you for coming to Chiapas; you did an excellent job.


